## SCHOOL UNIFORM

### GIRLS

Jersey	Regulation red V-necked jersey.
Shirt	Regulation girls' green polo with school monogram.
Skirt	Regulation charcoal skirt, worn on or below the knee.
Footwear	Plain black leather lace-up shoes that can be polished. <u>Terms 1 &amp; 4 only:</u> Plain black or dark brown flat sandals with straps over heel, worn as designed and in a neat, tidy condition. No jandals.
Socks/Stockings	Plain black school socks to be worn with shoes. Plain black coloured pantyhose may be worn (no ribbed or patterned pantyhose).
Phys-Ed	Regulation T-shirt in house colour, worn with black shorts.
Jackets	Regulation Green and black College jacket. Regulation Green lightweight rain jacket. These are the only jackets to be worn in school.
Trousers	Plain charcoal trousers only. Waistband must be above hips. To be worn with shoes and black socks. No sandals to be worn with long trousers.

### BOYS

Jersey	Regulation red V-necked jersey.
Shirt	Regulation boys' green polo with school monogram.
Shorts	Regulation charcoal school shorts. Waistband must be above hips. Hems must be above or on the knee. Belts may be black or dark brown.
Footwear	Plain black leather lace-up shoes that can be polished. <u>Terms 1 &amp; 4 only:</u> Plain black or dark brown flat sandals with straps over heel, worn as designed and in a neat, tidy condition.
Socks	Regulation black with bands of dark green and maroon.
Phys-Ed	Regulation T-shirt in house colour, worn with black shorts.
Jackets	Regulation Green and black College jacket. Regulation Green lightweight rain jacket. These are the only jackets to be worn in school.
Trousers	Plain charcoal trousers only. Waistband must be above hips. To be worn with shoes and black socks. No sandals to be worn with long trousers.

## MISCELLANEOUS

Jewellery	<b>NO</b> jewellery to be worn other than the following: small, plain ear studs; a wrist watch; one necklace of cultural, religious or personal significance; Medic-Alert bracelets. The College takes no responsibility for confiscated jewellery.
School Hat/Cap (optional)	Regulation school hat/cap may be worn outside only for sun protection. Cap peaks to be worn to the front only.
Scarf (optional)	Regulation scarf (red, green & white) may be worn.
Hair	Students' hair must be clean and tidy at all times. No extremes of fashion acceptable (e.g. Mohawks, unusual hair colour, etc.). Boys must be clean-shaven at all times.
Hair accessories	Black hair bands and hair ties only.
Under garments	Plain undergarments may be worn. They must not be visible at the collar, below the length of the shirt or below the sleeves.
Sunglasses	May be worn outside only and are the responsibility of student. Sunglasses are not permitted to be worn on the head in class.
